By confirming participation via email to LondonBihu@gmail.com and submitting payment, the Stallholder agrees to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions.

1. Stall Price

Stall fees are as follows:

- **£45** where the Stallholder sponsors a Bihu competition by donating a significant prize related to their stall products.
- **£55** where no sponsorship is provided.

The stall fee is separate from and in addition to the applicable event entry ticket, which must also be purchased.

Stall allocations are confirmed only once full payment has been received.

2. Payment

Full payment must be received by Tuesday, 31 March 2026. Failure to make payment by the deadline may result in forfeiture of the stall allocation.

3. Cancellation & Refunds

- 100% refund if written notice is provided more than 14 days before the event.
- 50% refund if written notice is provided between 48 hours and 14 days before the event.
- No refund within 48 hours of the event.

The Committee reserves the right to cancel the event due to circumstances beyond its control. In such cases, stall fees will be refunded.

4. Stall

- The hall will be open from 12.30pm. **Stallholders must arrive by 1:30pm**
- All stalls must be dismantled by 8:30pm
- One table (approx. 90cm x 140cm) will be provided
- Power supply is limited and not guaranteed

5. Disclaimer

Stallholders are fully responsible for ensuring compliance with all applicable UK laws and regulations including: food hygiene regulations, allergen labelling requirements, consumer protection legislation, and health & safety obligations.

All allergens must be clearly displayed for any food items.

The London Bihu Committee reserves the right to request removal of any stall that does not meet appropriate safety standards.
